They suggest that you hang up and ring the bank/police back to ensure the call is genuine.

Don't be fooled – they stay on the line. They then tell you to read out or key in your PIN.



THE COURIER

They send a taxi/courier to you to collect your bank card. With this and your PIN, they spend your money.

Your bank or the police will never ask for your PIN or bank card - don't give them to anybody!
